1. ISIMM junior prize

This prize, now at its first edition, was open to any researcher (not necessarily ISIMM member), who had made significant contributions linking Mathematics and Mathematical Physics, and had been born after January 1, 1976.

Six candidates were proposed; it was decided to disclose just the name of the winner(s).

Their curricula were submitted to the Executive Committee, who was charged of selecting the awardee, just as for the recently awarded ISIMM senior prize.

The Executive Committee has been impressed by the high quality of all of the candidates, and eventually decided to award the prize ex aequo to

Prof. Dr. Elisabetta Rocca and Dr. Stefan Neukamm.

The prize will be awarded, jointly with the senior ISIMM prize, in a special session chaired by professor Ingo Müller, at the STAMM conference in Poitiers, Sept. 8-11, 2014.
